Crating Information

We will have a crating setup that allows for social distancing between exhibitors in the crating area. Crating space will primarily be on dirt on the arena floor. No crating in the hallways this year. **Please set up your crates in the designated marked area ONLY.** The trial committee may remove any crates that are set up out of the marked area or prior to published set up time. **Only families or people traveling together can crate in close proximity to each other, otherwise exhibitors must follow social distancing guidelines (crating 6 feet apart).** **Masks will be required to be worn inside at all times except when running your dog or eating and drinking in the crating area.** No ex-pens and please stack your crates, especially if you have unentered dogs. **Please do not set up before 4:00 p.m. on Thursday.**

\$13 - Each additional entry per day each dog (includes \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee)

If you do not return the document, you will not be allowed to run at the trial.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or are of a registrable breed that have obtained a PAL or ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind, or dogs suffering

from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. This event is accepting entries for dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

Moving Up To The Next Class

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is received by October 26, 2020, at 5:00 pm. Move-ups over the weekend will be accommodated provided the information is provided before the trial ends on Friday or Saturday.

Prizes & Awards

Rosettes for 1st place teams in each jump height in each class, including T2B. Strip ribbons will be awarded to the 2nd through 4th teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive rosettes or ribbons. QQ ribbons will be available for dogs earning a Q in Master STD & JWW on the same day; QQQ ribbons for Master STD, JWW, and FAST on the same day. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Titling rosettes will be awarded for each titling dog. There are MACH/PACH/PAX bars and ribbons for dogs earning their MACH/PACH/PAX.

Course Walk-Throughs & Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during the walk-through period held prior to the start of class. It is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. We will be splitting and doing walkthroughs in limited numbers for the safety of our exhibitors, judge, and workers. More information will follow in the confirmation letter as we finalize the plans for the trial. Please do not touch any of the equipment during the walkthroughs. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided.

Jump Height Cards

Jump height cards are no longer required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has been changed to indicate whether the dog has been issued a temporary or permanent height card, or needs to be measured. During the COVID pandemic, dogs are not required to be measured in order to run. Judges of record are not required to measure dogs. Exhibitors without any measurement for their dog are asked to be honest and realistic about what jump height their dog should be running.

Important Withdrawal Information

If you wish to withdraw your dog prior to closing, all requests **MUST BE MADE IN WRITING AND CONFIRMED**. Please email the Trial Secretary. If you do not receive a confirmation back, your dog has **NOT BEEN** withdrawn.

Notice to Exhibitors

*** The Trial site will be available to exhibitors after 4:00 pm on Thursday, October 29, and 7:00 am on Friday, October 30 through Sunday, November 1. Please only set up in designated areas and maintain six feet social distancing from other exhibitors.**

*The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this Show, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

*Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

*Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial can't be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

*It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.

*Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Envelopes are limited to 10 entries. No staples, please!

*Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division for regular classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. In the Preferred classes, dogs may only be entered in their proper jump height division.

***Bitches in season and injured dogs** are not permitted to compete in Agility Show. **Entry fee will be refunded in full for bitches in season. Entry fee less the AKC recording fee will be refunded for injured dogs.** The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand delivered, emailed or postmarked at least thirty (30) minutes before the trial commences.

*All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.

*Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. **Please** help us keep this site clean for future use.

*Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

*The Little Rock Dog Training Club, its officers and Board members, Agility Trial Chair and Committee, the Trial Secretary, their agents, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors of their dogs or property. *YOU are responsible for any damage you or your dog(s) cause at the show site. Event Committee will be convened for cause.

*YOU are responsible for any damage you or your dog(s) cause at the show and/or hotel/motel grounds. Help us continue to offer you a wide selection of places to stay by cleaning up after your dog and ensuring that you, as a responsible dog owner, and your dogs are always welcomed. Event Committee will be convened for cause.

*Neither the Saline County Fairgrounds nor the LRDTTC will be responsible for property left overnight in the arena. No dogs should be left in arena overnight.

*Exhibitors should carry the original valid official Jump Height Card at each trial to present upon request.

From the east on I-30 take exit 116 toward Sevier St./ South St., turn right to cross back over I-30, take 1st right turn over the bridge then turn left onto the I-30 Frontage Rd. and then left into the Saline County Fairgrounds.

From the west on I-30 take exit 116 toward Sevier St., turn left on I-30 Frontage Rd. and continue west to the Fairgrounds on the right.



CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE 1/1/2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend and Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day.

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, FEO may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give

AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO is only allowed in the T2B and FAST classes. **FEO will be offered all days at this trial (T2B-Fri. & Sat., and FAST-Sun).**

The exhibitor must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying. FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the exhibitor will declare the day of show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the exhibitor is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO at the start line. Day of show jump changes are not allowed. Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the exhibitor is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO at the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed. The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (i.e. when checking in at the gate board). **Toys are allowed in the ring, but they must be non-audible, must not leave the exhibitor's hand, and may not roll freely. Food and treats are not allowed in the ring.** Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled, and the exhibitor will be dismissed from the ring.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, FNG will be offered on a one-year pilot basis to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a nonqualifying score.



Reserved RV Parking

There is RV parking with electric hookups (primarily 30 amp.) available at the Saline County Fairgrounds for a cost of \$20 a night. There is no dump station.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

COVID-19 INFORMATION FOR THE LRDTTC AGILITY TRIAL

Coronavirus/COVID-19 has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. It is extremely contagious and is believed to be spread mainly from person to person. Our goal is to take the necessary precautions to protect everyone and still be able to participate with our dogs in the sport we love. We ask for your cooperation in meeting this goal. Along this line, we will be following the AR Department of Health COVID-19 Directives and Orders and using AKC COVID-19 Best Practice as a guide at the trial. The Agility Committee will provide gloves for workers, clean common surfaces, and have hand sanitizer available for use. Some of the precautions we will be taking are listed below. There may be changes or additions as we get closer to the trial, and any updated information will be provided to you. **If you are unable or unwilling to follow these precautions and rules, please don't enter our trial.**

- 1. Please don't come to the trial if you are sick, have a family member who is sick, or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 within the last 14 days.** LRDTTC will refund the entry fees (minus all AKC recording fees and judge's fees for each day) of any exhibitor who needs to withdraw from the trial after the closing date because of this. No written medical excuse will be needed, but please e-mail the Trial Secretary at Sawyer422@aol.com.
- 2. Exhibitors must sign the COVID-19 Waiver of Liability and return it to the Trial Secretary before the closing date to run at the trial. The document will be sent to you with your confirmation e-mail.**
3. We will be having a one-ring trial to allow for ample crating space and less congestion.
4. We will have designated crating space, and exhibitors may only crate in those designated spaces or out of their vehicles.
5. Exhibitors must crate six feet away from each other unless they are family or traveling together.
6. Exhibitors will not be required to wear a mask while running their dog on the agility course but will be required to wear it coming and leaving the ring when running your dog and inside the trial site at all times unless eating or drinking. As a courtesy to others, we ask that exhibitors consider wearing a mask when being outside of the trial site and unloading when you cannot maintain a six-foot distance from other exhibitors.
7. No spectators will be allowed at the trial.
8. We encourage exhibitors to bring their own gloves, masks, hand sanitizer, and pen.
9. There will be no printed course maps available at the trial site. Course maps will be posted at the trial site and sent to exhibitors the night before by e-mail.
10. Ribbons will not be self-serve but will be available to the exhibitors at a designated place after the class is completed.
11. There will be no food or drinks provided at the trial. There should be no MACH/PACH parties or communal food.
