Envelopes containing entries for more than the ten-dog maximum will be treated as an invalid entry and will be returned to the sender. No entries will be accepted by phone or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. **A signed COVID waiver must be returned to Trial Secretary before the trial.**

LRDTC is accepting online entries through [www.labtestedonline.com](http://www.labtestedonline.com). During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries: 30% (105), paper entries 70% (245), 350 runs per day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

LRDTC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing October 22, 2021 at 6:00 pm CST. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to October 22, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. Any entries withdrawn that are received by November 1, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. will be replaced by a wait-listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by November 1, 2020, will receive a full refund.

Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season and injured dogs are not permitted to compete in the agility trials. Entry fee will be refunded in full for bitches in season. Entry fee less the AKC recording fee will be refunded for injured dogs. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand delivered, emailed or postmarked at least thirty (30) minutes before the trial commences. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

**Important withdraw information--** if you wish to withdraw your dog prior to closing, all requests **MUST BE MADE IN WRITING AND CONFIRMED**. Please email the Trial Secretary. If you do not receive a confirmation back, your dog has not been withdrawn. **No entry fees** will be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the club, trial committee or trial secretary.

## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or are of a registrable breed that have obtained a PAL or ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. This event is accepting entries for dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

## MOVE UPS TO THE NEXT CLASS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, because of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is received by November 1, 2021, at 6:00 pm. Move-ups over the weekend will be accommodated provided the information is provided before the trial ends on Friday or Saturday.

### **COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM UP INFORMATION**

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during the walk-through period held prior to the start of class. The course walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only and will be split as needed to minimize the number of handlers in each walk-through group. Further details will be in the final confirmation. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided. The agility gate app will be used at this trial for check in and running order.

### **PRIZES AND AWARDS**

Rosettes for 1st place teams in each jump height in each class, including T2B. Strip ribbons will be awarded to the 2nd through 4th teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive rosettes or ribbons. QQ ribbons will be available for dogs earning a Q in Master STD & JWW on the same day; QQQ ribbons for Master STD, JWW, and FAST on the same day. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Titling rosettes will be awarded for each titling dog. There are MACH/PACH/PAX bars and ribbons for dogs earning their MACH/PACH/PAX. A personalized rosette ribbon will be awarded to dogs earning their AGCH.

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete. **As of March 1, 2021, if a VMO or Agility Field Representative is measuring dogs at a trial, all present and entered dogs without a valid measurement must be measured. Until further notice, Judges of Record who are not VMOs will still not measure dogs.** Exhibitors without any measurement for their dog are asked to be honest and realistic about what jump height their dog should be running.

### Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to Be Measured List.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION AND RULE CHANGES

**Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day** Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

## ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. **FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.**

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. **FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the trial.**
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of trial jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of trial level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

## FIX AND GO

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

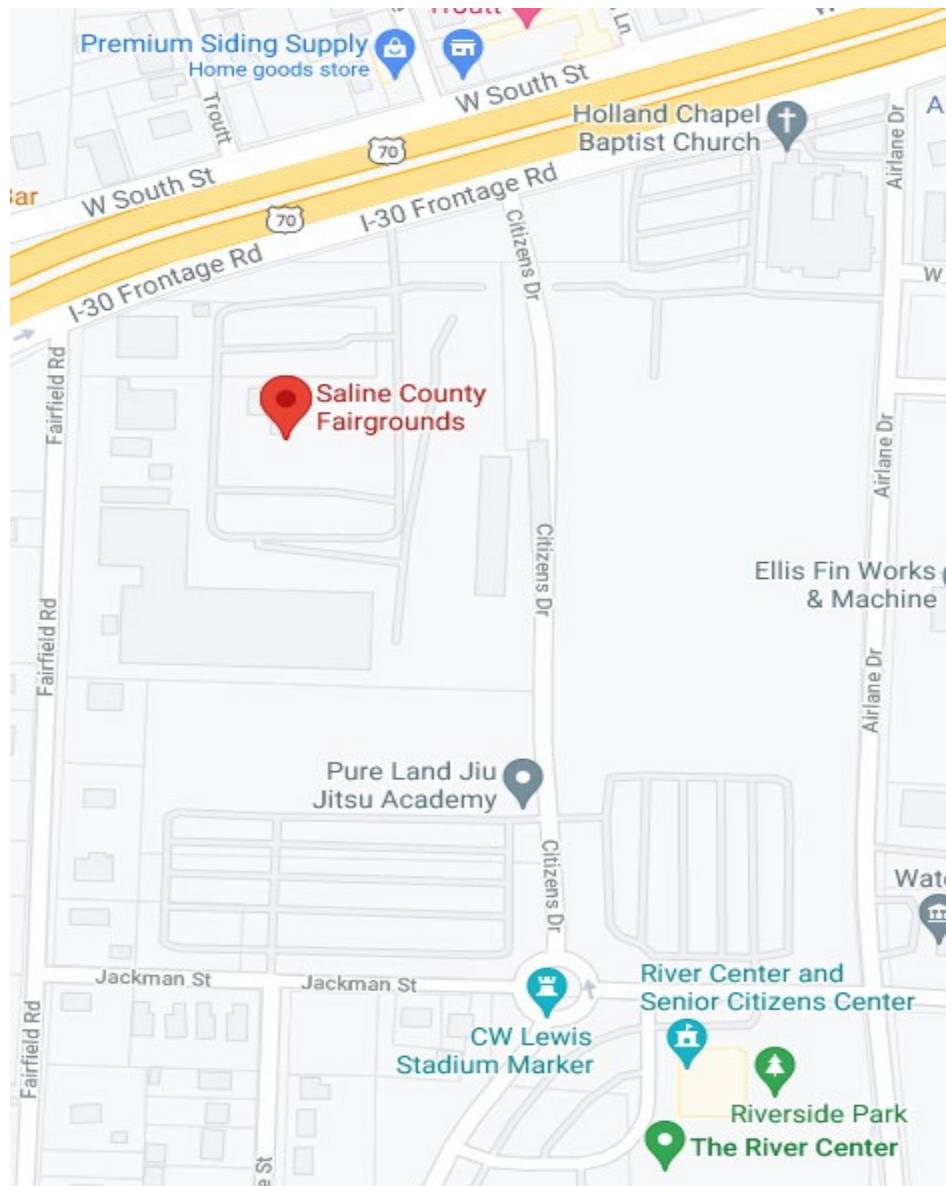
## RV INFORMATION

**From the east** on I-30 take exit 116 toward Sevier St./ South St., turn right to cross back over I-30, take 1<sup>st</sup> right turn over the bridge then turn left onto the I-30 Frontage Rd. and then left into the Saline County Fairgrounds. The turn in for the Fairgrounds is past the turn in for Riverside Park.

**From the west** on I-30 take exit 116 toward Sevier St., turn left on I-30 Frontage Rd. and continue west to the Fairgrounds on the right.

The Little Rock Dog Training Club, its officers and Board members, Agility Trial Chair and Committee, the Trial Secretary, their agents, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors of their dogs or property. YOU are responsible for any damage you or your dog(s) cause at the trial site. The Trial Committee will be convened for cause. The trial site is a covered horse arena, which is partially open on the sides. It is impossible to totally secure the area at night. Please do not leave valuable items at the trial site at night. Neither the Saline County Fairgrounds nor the LRDTTC will be responsible for property left overnight at the trial site. No dogs should be left in arena overnight.



You are responsible for any damage you or your dog(s) cause at the trial and/or hotel/motel grounds. The Trial Committee will be convened for cause. Help us continue to offer you a wide selection of places to stay by cleaning up after your dog and ensuring that you, as a responsible dog owner, and your dogs are always welcomed.



It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times or otherwise confined when on trial site except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.



Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial site. the exhibitors, their dogs, or property.

I further agree to defend and indemnify the released parties for any and all claims brought by a third party that arise from my or my dog's attendance at the LRDTC trials as it relates to Coronavirus/COVID-19. I understand and agree that this release includes any claims based on the actions and omissions of LRDTC, its Board Members, Trial Committee, members, volunteers, agents, and representatives, whether Coronavirus/COVID-19 exposure/infection occurs before, during, or after being at the LRDTC trials. In the event that LRDTC deems it necessary to employ legal counsel to protect its rights under this agreement and the Court finds in favor of LRDTC, I agree to indemnify and pay all attorney's fees and costs incurred by LRDTC.

Further, by signing this Waiver, I agree that I will comply fully with all preventative measures and rules made by LRDTC for the trials. I understand that if I fail to comply, I may be asked to leave the trial and no trial fees will be refunded to me, and I may be refused entry in future trials.
