T2B, Standard, and JWW will run all three days. FAST will run on Friday and Saturday. Premier JWW will run on Friday and Premier STD will run on Saturday.

Friday Sequence: FAST, T2B, E/M STD, Premier JWW, Open STD, E/M JWW, Nov STD, Open JWW, Nov JWW

Saturday Sequence: FAST, T2B, Premier STD, E/M JWW, E/M STD, Open JWW, Open STD, Nov JWW, Nov STD (**different running order for Open and Novice than Friday**).

Sunday Sequence: T2B, JWW & STD (All Classes)

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or are of a registrable breed that have obtained a PAL or ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. This event is accepting entries for dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

Moving Up To The Next Class

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is received by April 20, 2020, at 5:00 pm. Move-ups over the Weekend will be accommodated provided the information is provided before the trial ends on Friday or Saturday.

Prizes & Awards

Rosettes for 1st place teams in each jump height in each class, including T2B. Strip ribbons will be awarded to the 2nd through 4th teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive rosettes or ribbons. QQ ribbons will be available for dogs earning a Q in Master STD & JWW on the same day; QQQ ribbons for Master STD, JWW, and FAST on the same day. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Titling rosettes will be awarded for each titling dog. There are MACH/PACH/PAX bars and ribbons for dogs earning their MACH/PACH/PAX.

Course Walk-Throughs & Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during the walk-through period held prior to the start of class. It is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. The walkthrough period allows handlers to plan their strategy prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided.

Jump Height Cards

Jump height cards are no longer required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has been changed to indicate whether the dog has been issued a temporary or permanent height card, or needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running by the Judge of Record. This measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only.

Notice to Exhibitors

*** The Trial site will be available to exhibitors after 4:00 pm on Thursday, April 23 and 7:00 am on Friday April 24 through Sunday April 26. Crate space is limited, no exercise pens, please.**

*The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this Show, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

*Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

*Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial can't be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

*It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.

*Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

*Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division for regular classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. In the Preferred classes, dogs may only be entered in their proper jump height division.

***Bitches in season and injured dogs** are not permitted to compete in Agility Show. **Entry fee will be refunded in full for bitches in season. Entry fee less the AKC recording fee will be refunded for**

injured dogs. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand delivered, emailed or postmarked at least thirty (30) minutes before the trial commences.

*All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.

*Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. **Please help us keep this site clean for future use.**

*Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

*The Little Rock Dog Training Club, its officers and Board members, Agility Trial Chair and Committee, the Trial Secretary, their agents, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors of their dogs or property. *YOU are responsible for any damage you or your dog(s) cause at the show site. Event Committee will be convened for cause.

*YOU are responsible for any damage you or your dog(s) cause at the show and/or hotel/motel grounds. CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE 1/1/2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend and Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day.

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO is only allowed in the T2B and FAST classes. The host club has the option of whether to offer FEO. **LRDTC will NOT be offering FEO at this trial.**

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, FNG will be offered on a one-year pilot basis to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a nonqualifying score.
